Module 1.4: Standard 1 Field Training Course

Standard 1 - Tree and Stand Dynamics
Demonstrable Competency: 4) Demonstrate the integration of the individual competencies within Standard 1

Course Description

The overall objectives of Module 1.4 are to integrate student's knowledge and comprehension of the various demonstrable competencies that comprise Standard 1. Specific objectives are for students to apply field techniques for identifying and describing plants, recognizing and describing current and past tree and stand conditions, appreciating the processes that lead to those tree and stand conditions, and developing simple models for representing and future stand conditions. Integrating these objectives will occur in the field through exercises, which, for example, simultaneously require the identification of plants in order to estimate processes that resulted in the current and past stand conditions. This field training will include a final assignment that is based on data and information collected by the students in the field.
